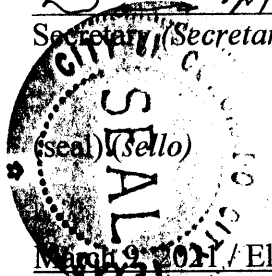

ORDINANCE NO. 2021 - 04

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLORADO CITY, TEXAS, DECLARING THE UNOPPOSED CANDIDATES FOR THE OFFICE OF MAYOR, CITY COUNCIL MEMBER DISTRICT NUMBER 2, AND CITY COUNCIL MEMBER DISTRICT NUMBER 5 AS ELECTED; PROVIDING THAT THE MAY 1, 2021, REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTION FOR MAYOR, CITY COUNCIL MEMBER DISTRICT 2, AND CITY COUNCIL MEMBER DISTRICT 5 SHALL NOT BE HELD; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH; PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; FINDING AND DETERMINING THAT THE MEETING AT WHICH THE ORDINANCE WAS PASSED WAS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC AS REQUIRED BY LAW; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Colorado City, Texas on January 12, 2021, ordered a regular municipal election to be held on Saturday, May 1, 2021, for the purpose of electing a Mayor and three officials of the City, to wit: City Council Member District #1, City Council Member District #2, and City Council Member District #5; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 143.007 and 146.054, Texas Election Code, the deadlines for filing applications for a place on the ballot and declaration of write-in candidacy for the City's regular municipal election have expired; and

WHEREAS, the City Secretary, in accordance with Section 2.052, Texas Election Code, has certified in writing to the City Council that Robert Oliver, Ruben Hurt, and Leon Dickard are unopposed for election to the office of Mayor, City Council Member District #2, and City Council Member District #5; and

WHEREAS, the City Council hereby finds and determines that the candidates whose name is to appear on the ballot in said election for Mayor, City Council Member District #2, and City Council Member District #5 are unopposed, there are no declared write-in candidates, and no propositions to appear on the ballot for said election;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLORADO CITY, THAT:

1.

The facts and matters set forth in the preamble of this Ordinance are hereby found to be true and correct.

2.

In accordance with Section 2.053(a), Texas Election Code, the following unopposed candidates are hereby declared duly elected to the respective offices shown and shall be issued certificates of election following the date on which the regular municipal election for Mayor, City Council Member District 2, and City Council Member District 5 was to have been held:

Mayor – Robert Oliver
City Council Member District 2 – Ruben Hurt
City Council Member District 5 – Leon Dickard

3.

Pursuant to Section 2.053(b), Texas Election Code, the regular municipal election for Mayor, City Council Member District 2, and City Council Member District 5 heretofore called and ordered for May 4, 2019, shall not be held and is hereby canceled.

4.

The City Secretary is hereby directed to cause a copy of this Ordinance to be posted on Election Day, same being May 1, 2021, at all polling places that would have been used in such election.

5.

All ordinance or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

6.

The Code of the City of Colorado City, Texas, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect, save and except as amended by this ordinance.

7.

Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase or word of this ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid for any purpose by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected thereby, and to this end the provisions of the ordinance are declared to be severable.

8.

It is hereby found and determined that the meeting at which this ordinance was passed was open to the public as required by Section 551.001 et seq., Texas Government Code, and that advance public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given.


9.

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption by the City Council.
