

County Auditor Heidi Harris presented an agreement with DebtBook Software for consideration. The software, GASB 87, will be used for all equipment leases. Cost is \$1,500 for setting up the software and \$5,000 per year. Due to new laws, the county's two options are: purchase the software or hire an outside CPA to perform the services.

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7. <u>Discuss Proposed Housing Development Incentive</u>

Ty Wood, attorney, presented the idea of a housing development incentive paying developers a percentage of the cost based on the square footage of the house being built. The city's Economic Development Corporation is pursuing the incentive and is requesting the county be open to the same incentive. Wood said no new houses have been built here since 2014. All commissioners expressed support for the program.
